## 2. How to Find the Best Consultancy Near You — Step by Step

**Step 1 – Google Search with Location:** Start with a targeted Google search: 'placement consultancy in [your city]' or 'recruitment agency near [your area/locality]'. What to listen for: This gives you a sense of the agency's current activity level and success rate. A quiet agency is unlikely to prioritise your profile vigorously.

**Q: What is your screening and submission process?**

What to listen for: Understand how your profile will be presented to employers — a professional candidate brief is far more effective than just forwarding your PDF resume unchanged.

**Q: Do you charge candidates any fee?**

What to listen for: The answer should be NO for domestic permanent placements. Any attempt to charge a registration or processing fee for local jobs is a serious red flag.

**Q: What is your replacement guarantee if the placed candidate leaves early?**

What to listen for: A 30–60 day replacement commitment (in writing) for the employer is standard practice at quality agencies and reflects their confidence in the quality of their placements.

## 4. Red Flags: How to Identify Fake or Fraudulent Consultancies

- **Unverifiable Office Address:** Always physically verify the agency's office before paying any fee. Fraudulent agencies often operate from residential addresses or share unregistered office spaces with no professional setup.
- **No Digital Presence:** A legitimate consultancy in 2025 will have a website, a Google My Business listing, and some social media activity. An agency with zero online presence is very likely not a professional operation.
- **Pressure Tactics:** High-pressure sales tactics like 'limited seats available', 'register today for a special discount', or 'this company is interviewing only this week' are manipulation techniques used by fraudulent agencies to extract fees quickly.
- **Overseas Job Frauds:** For international placements, always verify the agency's Protector of Emigrants (POE) registration number on the MEA's eMigrate portal. Unregistered overseas placement agencies operating in cities like Jalandhar have been responsible for serious human trafficking and labour exploitation cases.
- **Unrecognised Payment Methods:** Never pay fees via personal UPI IDs, cash, or in the recruiter's personal name. Always demand a proper GST invoice for any service payment.
